

The Conservation Board accepts applications at any time from individuals interested in serving as Board members.

When openings occur, applications are reviewed and eligible applicants are interviewed. Applicants must be a resident of the Town or Village of Victor. Other factors may also be considered in the selection process.

We suggest before submitting your application you:

- Attend two Conservation Board meetings.
- Introduce yourself to Board members.
- Be certain you can commit the time and effort required of a member. Members serve 5 year terms and meet 2 times a month. Members also spend time reading the support data for project referrals.
- Keep in mind that there are also project site walks and members are required to complete 4 hours of training per year.
