

High Street Project Update – 1/15/10

A concept plan and PowerPoint presentation has been developed in preparation for a public information meeting to be held in February. A workshop with the Town Board at the end of January will be held in advance of setting the date for the Public Information meeting. The goals of the workshop will be to refine the project scope, project potential costs, and consider the scheduling of project activities.

LaBella Associates is currently assisting the Town of Victor, Ontario County, in developing concept plans for a capital improvement project on High Street in the northwest quadrant of the town. The project limits are currently the town/village line in the south, and NYS Route 96 at Eastview in the north. This project length is approximately 2.7 miles.

The project will likely install sidewalk along one side of the road, rehabilitate the asphalt pavement, and widen the pavement to three lanes at isolated sections. Drainage improvements will be made to accommodate additional pavement. The existing water main will be replaced from the village line north to Lane Road. A short sanitary sewer extension is being considered in the vicinity of the Victor Central School District driveway.

Our discussions with the Town Board regarding schedule concluded that this project will likely proceed in two phases. The first phase will be the installation of utility improvements and will begin in 2010. The second phase will include the highway improvements and will most likely begin in 2011.
