Subject: Process for Water Supply Connections to Town Public Water

The following is the process that we have established to provide connections to our Town's Water Supply at no cost to you. This step is another in our continuing efforts to fully implement our Town's Value Protection Plan (VPP) for Modock Spring's residents. It also shows the promise of the partnership that has been developing among Syracuse Sand and Gravel, Inc. (SS&G), the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), the Modock Springs Citizens Advisory Committee (MSCAC), and the Town of Victor.

The Town, SS&G, and the NYSDEC have jointly developed this plan to connect your residence up to our Town's Water Supply. This connection will not cost you anything. All work will be coordinated with the Town Water Department and will fully comply with our Town Code.

After your connection to the Town's Water Supply is completed, you will be responsible for paying for future water usage. You will also be required to sign a standard access agreement/liability release before the work is initiated and an acceptance indicating that you are satisfied with the work after it has been completed. We will return your yard to substantially the same condition as we found it.

We hope to accomplish this work in August and September. In order for you to participate in this free water hook up you must reply to this note by August 21, 2009. Please contact Paul Lytle at 739-2816 to arrange a preliminary inspection of your current water connection and to suggest a time for your water connection to be completed.

I want to acknowledge once again that the NYSDEC has stated that your current well water is safe to drink. They have sampled and analyzed your well water on more than one occasion. However, I hope you take advantage of this offer. It will add value to your home and will serve as an extra safeguard. Participating in this water connection program is also a requirement for full participation in the Town's VPP.
