Route 96 Over Mud Creek Bridge Replacement

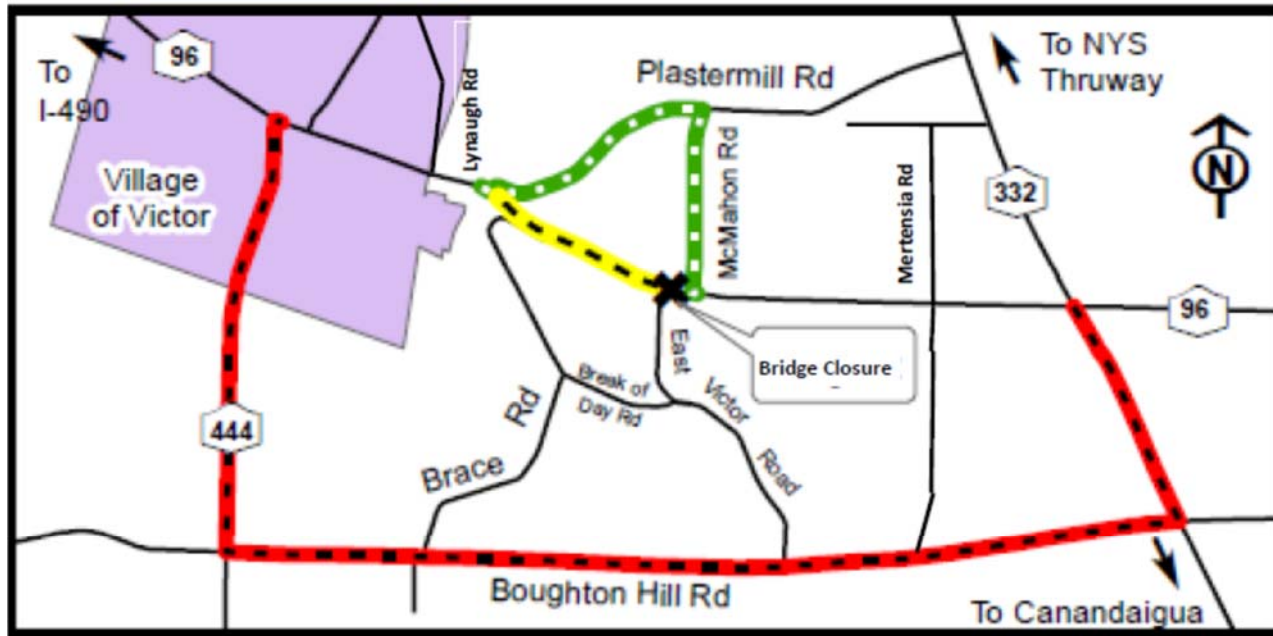

Traffic Control:

- The bridge is located on Route 96 between East Victor Road and McMahon Road. The bridge is anticipated to be closed for three months in the **Summer of 2018**.
- Access to all residences and businesses will be maintained throughout the project. Those with a destination between the “road closed” sign and the work site will be permitted access.
- Two detours will be posted to direct traffic around the work site for approximately three months while the bridge is closed to traffic.
- Cars** will be directed to use Plastermill and McMahon Roads to bypass the bridge.
- Commercial **trucks** will be directed to follow the truck detour route utilizing Route 444, Boughton Hill Road, and Route 332.
