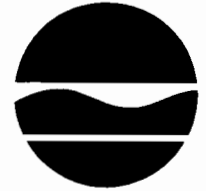

Dear Supervisor Bamann:

The following is a chronologic summary of activities related to the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) currently being completed at the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., site. This summary includes activities occurring since the last update provided to the Town of Victor on November 21, 2007.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

November 23, 2007 - December 7, 2007

November 27, 2007 - NYSDEC and NYSDOH staff completed review of the draft Immediate Investigation Work Assignment (IIWA) summary report submitted by Malcolm Pirnie in October 2007. The final IIWA report is expected to be received by mid-to-late December 2007. Once the final IIWA report is received by the NYSDEC, it will be placed in the document repositories and forwarded to the Town of Victor for placement on the Town's website.

November 28 & 29, 2007 - NYSDEC and NYSDOH participated in Availability Sessions at the Town of Victor Town Hall at 1290 Blossom Drive. The Availability Sessions were held from 12:00 - 4:00 PM and from 5:00 - 8:00 PM on Wednesday, November 28, 2007 and from 8:00 - 11:00 AM on Thursday, November 29, 2007. Based on sign-in sheets, approximately 30 people participated in the Availability Sessions.

December 3, 2007 - NYSDEC and NYSDOH staff completed review of the draft Focused Feasibility Study for Groundwater Interim Remedial Measure (IRM) summary report submitted by Malcolm Pirnie in October 2007. The final IRM report is expected to be received by mid-to-late January 2008. Once the final IRM report is received by the NYSDEC, it will be placed in the document repositories and forwarded to the Town of Victor for placement on the Town's website.

December 6, 2007 - NYSDEC staff forwarded electronic versions of the posters that were on display during the Availability Session to the Town of Victor for placement on the Town's website.


Ongoing - NYSDEC staff continue to prepare for expanded vapor intrusion sampling to verify boundaries established during the vapor intrusion program completed early in 2007. Expanded vapor intrusion sampling is scheduled to start on December 11, 2007.

Ongoing - NYSDEC and NYSDOH staff continue to respond to periodic telephone calls and requests for information.

Ongoing - NYSDEC and NYSDOH staff continue to prepare updates to the Town of Victor prior to Town Board meetings on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
