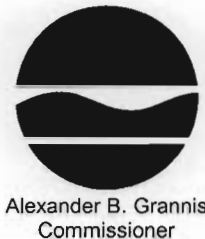

Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., Site Update

Dear Supervisor Bamann:

The following is a chronologic summary of activities related to the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) currently being completed at the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., site. This update includes activities occurring since the last update provided on March 21, 2008.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

March 21, 2008 - April 4, 2008

April 2, 2008 - To evaluate soil quality and possible contaminant disposal areas, New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) staff are making arrangements to complete a test pit/trench program at the Syracuse Sand and Gravel, Inc. property. It is expected that the test pit/trench program will be completed in April 2008 as site conditions permit access.

April 1, 2008 - Completed physical testing of one mitigation system. In total, between January 30, 2008 and April 1, 2008, physical testing was completed at eight (8) homes that had volunteered for the additional testing. Department staff started mailing letters on April 3, 2008 summarizing the results of physical testing of these mitigation systems.

March 26, 2008 - Following the third party data validator's review of the vapor intrusion sampling data collected between December 11, 2007 and January 7, 2008, Department staff met with New York State Department of Health staff to discuss the vapor intrusion sampling data. Department staff are currently evaluating the laboratory analytical results before accepting the data as final.

The third party data validator is currently reviewing the final laboratory analytical results from the vapor intrusion sampling completed at one location on January 18, 2008. The Department is expecting to receive validated final laboratory analytical results for this location by mid-April 2008.


Ongoing - Department staff continue to review the revised version of the Focused Feasibility Study for Groundwater Interim Remedial Measure Report. Department staff are currently reviewing the revised report and expect to either issue additional comments or determine that the document is final and place it in the document repositories. It is expected that review of the revised report will be completed by April 2008. Based on the IRM evaluation, the Department Project Manager continues to prepare a Decision Document. The Decision Document will outline the proposed IRM action and it is expected to be available for public review early in 2008.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to respond to periodic telephone calls and requests for information.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to prepare updates to the Town of Victor prior to Town Board meetings on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
