Dear Supervisor Bamann:

The following is a chronologic summary of activities related to the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) currently being completed at the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., Site. This update includes activities occurring since the last update provided on May 2, 2008.

### SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

May 2, 2008 - May 16, 2008

May 14, 2008 - New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) staff completed physical testing of one mitigation system. In total, between January 30, 2008 and May 14, 2008, physical testing was completed at nine (9) homes that had volunteered for the additional testing. Department staff have provided letters to homeowners summarizing the results of physical testing at these locations.

May 14, 2008 - Established three (3) temporary spring sampling points along the east and west side of the primary Modock Road Springs to further assess groundwater discharge. Collected surface water samples from the three (3) spring sampling points and the primary Modock Road Springs for laboratory analysis.

May 14, 2008 - At the request of a resident, collected groundwater sample for laboratory analysis from one (1) residential well located on Dryer Road.

May 6, 2008 - Following Department and New York State Department of Health approval of the Focused Feasibility Study for Groundwater Interim Remedial Measure (IRM) Report, the IRM report was sent to the Victor Free Library document repository and was emailed to the Town of Victor Modock Springs Citizen Advisory Committee members.


Ongoing - Department staff will be participating in the May 21, 2008 Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee Meeting to discuss the IRM evaluation.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to respond to periodic telephone calls and requests for information.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to prepare updates to the Town of Victor prior to Town Board meetings on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
