Dear Supervisor Bamann:

The following is a chronologic summary of activities related to the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) currently being completed at the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., Site. This update includes activities occurring since the last update provided on May 16, 2008.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

May 16, 2008 - May 30, 2008

May 27, 2008 - New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) staff reviewed and provided comments on a Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee prepared letter regarding the Department's offer to complete physical testing of ventilation systems installed with the Senator Nozzolio grant.

May 20 - 22, 2008 - Department staff provided oversight during the installation of two (2) groundwater monitoring wells by Syracuse Sand and Gravel, Inc. The wells were installed on Syracuse property as part of the renewed mining permit requirements.

May 21, 2008 - Department staff participated in the May 21, 2008 Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee Meeting to discuss the Focused Feasibility Study for Groundwater Interim Remedial Measure (IRM) report. The Department expects to receive comments from the Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee on the IRM report.

May 16, 2008 - Following the 2007/2008 heating season vapor intrusion sampling at 19 locations, the results were summarized in New York State Department of Health homeowner letters and sent to the respective residents.


Ongoing - As part of the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., remedial investigation, the remaining portion of the drilling program has been scheduled for July 7, 2008. It is expected that monitoring wells will be installed during an approximate two (2) week period.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to respond to periodic telephone calls and requests for information.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to prepare updates to the Town of Victor prior to Town Board meetings on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
