Dear Supervisor Bamann:

The following is a chronologic summary of activities related to the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) currently being completed at the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., site. This update includes activities occurring since the last update provided on July 3, 2008.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

July 3, 2008 - July 25, 2008

July 23, 2008 - New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) staff scheduled physical testing appointments of three (3) ventilation systems installed with the Senator Nozzolio grant for the week of July 28, 2008. The physical testing appointments were prompted by residents receiving a Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee prepared letter regarding the Department's offer to complete physical testing of ventilation systems installed under the grant.

July 8 - July 17, 2008 - As part of the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., remedial investigation, a drilling program was completed during this two week period. A total of nine (9) groundwater monitoring wells were installed and four (4) soil borings were advanced. The drilling and monitoring well locations were selected to confirm groundwater plume boundaries and to better understand subsurface geologic and hydrogeologic conditions. The monitoring wells were installed at the following locations:

- Four (4) monitoring wells were installed along Dryer Road;
- One (1) well was installed at the end of Heather Lane;
- One (1) well was installed at the end of Trotwood Lane;
- One (1) well was installed along Modock Road; and
- Two (2) wells were installed on Syracuse Sand and Gravel, Inc., Property.

Following installation, the new monitoring wells were developed and are scheduled to be sampled during the week of July 28, 2008.

Ongoing - Department staff routinely communicate with Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee members. The Department expects to receive comments from the Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee on the Focused Feasibility Study for Groundwater Interim Remedial Measure report.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to respond to periodic telephone calls and requests for information.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to prepare updates to the Town of Victor prior to Town Board meetings on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
