Dear Supervisor Bamann:

The following is a chronologic summary of activities related to the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) currently being completed at the Modock Road Springs/DLS Sand and Gravel, Inc., site. This update includes activities occurring since the last update provided on August 8, 2008.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

August 8, 2008 - September 5, 2008

August 20, 2008 - Groundwater samples were collected from the nine (9) newly installed monitoring wells and surface water samples were collected from the Modock Road springs and submitted for laboratory analysis. The laboratory results should be received during the week of September 8, 2008.

August 26 - 29, 2008 - Malcolm Pirnie staff completed hydraulic conductivity testing at the nine (9) newly installed monitoring wells at the Modock Road Springs site. Hydraulic conductivity testing provides direct measurements of the overall permeability of the material around the well and allows for subsequent groundwater velocity/travel time calculations.

Ongoing - The RI/FS reports are being prepared. It is expected that the draft Remedial Investigation Report will be submitted by Malcolm Pirnie in early fall 2008.

Ongoing - Department staff routinely communicate with Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee members. The Department expects to receive comments from the Town of Victor Citizen Advisory Committee on the Focused Feasibility Study for Groundwater Interim Remedial Measure Report.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to respond to periodic telephone calls and requests for information.

Ongoing - Department staff continue to prepare updates to the Town of Victor prior to Town Board meetings on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
