## **Meeting to Discuss Environmental Health Follow-up for Village of Victor**

In response to concerns about past contamination of the Village of Victor public water supply, the New York State Department of Health would like to discuss the possibility of conducting a health statistics review of village residents. Volatile organic compounds (VOCs) were detected in one of the Village's water supply sources in 1990. This source was immediately taken out of service. Enclosed is an information sheet describing health statistics reviews. We are sending this information for your review and welcome your questions and comments.

## **Presentation and Question & Answer Period During Village Board Meeting**

A formal presentation describing the methods, strengths, and limitations of health statistics reviews will be held during the regularly scheduled Village Board of Trustees meeting on Monday, November 5, 2007. The portion of the meeting for the New York State Department of Health presentation is expected to begin around 7:30 PM.
