Meeting Minutes for January 26, 2022**

Old Business:

- a. Cemetery Preservation and Restoration Committee –Bob reported that the Wreathes Across America ceremony was well attended and successful. The Veterans that organized the event did a great job and the scouts were very helpful. There are some monuments in need of repairs. Bob has contacted Richard Doyle and is on his schedule for the spring. The cemetery reenactment will be scheduled in the next few days.

- b. Historian’s reports for November and December, 2021 were reviewed.

- d. Historic database on a website - share Wayne County site as a model - Babette has been working with Jim Paprocki, the Wayne County digital expert. Babette is coordinating with a student program out of Geneseo to help construct the database.

This might include Crossman’s Pond, an example of a kettle hole, prominent examples of drumlins, and possibly the kames in Hopper Hills.
