Residents who fail to comply with **ALL** Town refuse/recycling regulations will **NOT** be allowed to use the facility for any purpose!

NO PERMIT-NO DUMPING WILL BE ALLOWED

VALID PERMITS MUST BE DISPLAYED OR HANDED TO THE ATTENDANTS IN ORDER TO DUMP AT THE TRANSFER STATION.

WHEN ENTERING THE TRANSFER STATION, PLEASE MAKE SURE THE ONLY ITEMS IN YOUR TRUNK OR BACK OF VEHICLE ARE YOUR REFUSE / RECYCLING.

MISSING ITEMS WILL NOT BE COMPENSATED FOR OR REPLACED!

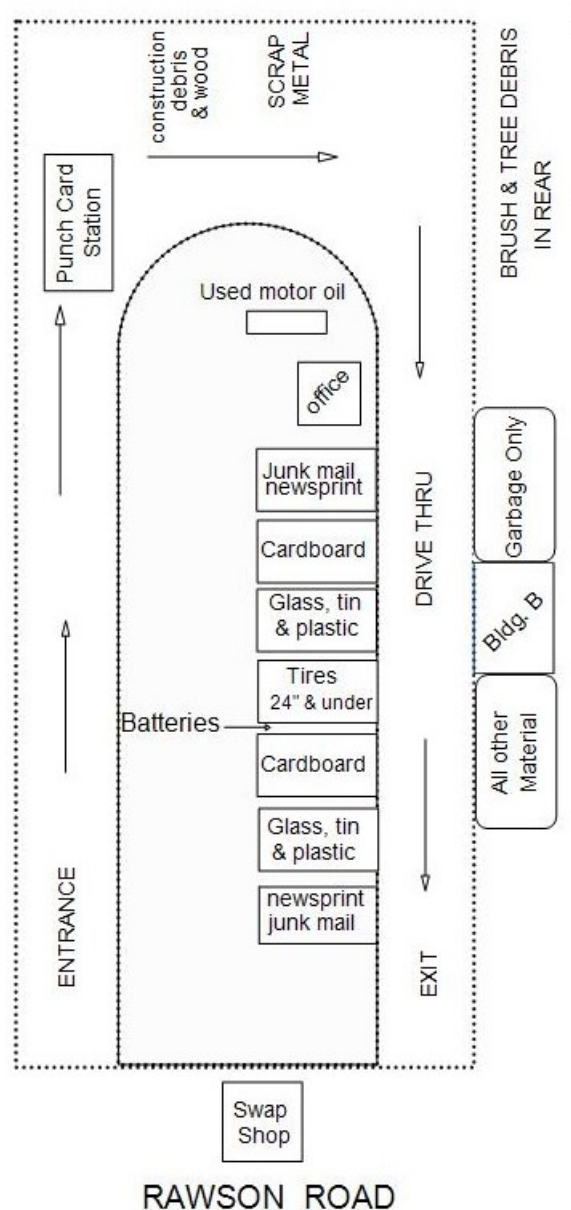

RECYCLABLES (Will Not Be Accepted in Plastic Bags)

Sort by category:

GLASS

ACCEPTED:

- Clear, brown and green. Please rinse.

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ NO drinking glasses, Pyrex dishware, window glass, incandescent or fluorescent bulbs, ceramics, mirrors, medical bottles

METAL

ACCEPTED:

- Empty aerosol cans & license plates
- Metal food & beverage containers. Please rinse & flatten to reduce volume.
- Metal appliances (except refrigerators)

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ NO propane, butane, helium tanks or gas tanks
- ◆ NO pesticide containers of any type

PLASTICS

ACCEPTED:

- Bottles, jugs & containers. Please rinse & flatten to reduce volume.
- Clean shopping bags (yellow toter)

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ NO STYROFOAM, 5-gallon pails
- ◆ Plastic toys, laundry baskets or furniture, hangers, motor oil or antifreeze containers



PAPER & CARDBOARD

ACCEPTED:

- Newspapers & inserts, MUST be dry and not bundled
- Boxboard (cereal boxes, etc.)
- Corrugated cardboard with ridges, MUST be reduced to maximum size of 4' X 4' & flattened
- Clean brown paper bags
- Junk mail, magazines & catalogs
- Shredded paper IN PAPER BAGS
- Office paper including colored/white, computer, post-its, soft-cover books, poster board, folders & envelopes

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ NO tissues, toilet paper & paper towels
- ◆ NO metallic paper or carbon paper

MUNICIPAL WASTE (HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE)

ACCEPTED:

- Refuse in plastic bags, brown paper bags or containers with loose trash
- Empty water based paint cans (must be solid or empty)

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ Containers over 75 pounds
- ◆ NO Bagged construction debris
- ◆ NO Household Hazardous Waste

ORGANICS

ACCEPTED:

- Through Bucket Exchange Program only (must get bucket at Transfer Station Office)
- At home compost educational materials available at Transfer Station Office

WOOD / BRUSH & LEAVES / GRASSES

ACCEPTED:

MATERIAL MUST BE SORTED ACCORDINGLY

- Leaves, grass, weeds, misc. plants on **left side** of containment area
- Wood & brush on **right side** of containment area (made into mulch)
- Brown biodegradable leaf bags

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ Leaves, grasses, etc in plastic bags

MISCELLANEOUS

ACCEPTED:

- Tires up to 24" **NO RIMS- Four (4) tire limit per household** (must have ticket for each tire-given with permit)
- Scrap metal (clean & separated/see outside attendant)
- Used motor oil
- Batteries, EXCEPT Car/Vehicle
- Ashes in designated bin

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ NO paint cans with paint left in them
- ◆ NO commercial waste of any type
- ◆ **NO Electronics (Computers/TVs)**
- ◆ **NO Microwaves**
- ◆ **NO Ammunition, Fireworks, or Explosives of any kind**

5-PUNCH CARD-\$100 Fee (for construction debris & large items)

ACCEPTED:

- Rugs, wood, dry wall, linoleum, tile, cabinets, doors, shingles, siding, etc.
- Large furniture/refrigerators, mattresses, sofa, air conditioners, humidifiers

NOT ACCEPTED:

- ◆ NO Rock, concrete
